America 250 Anniversary Events and Updates

Downtown Business Director Lagina Fitzpatrick shared that the downtown July 3 events are being finalized. Vendors, civic clubs, and locations where stations will be set up for serving food, water, and merchandise are being coordinated. The Laclede County Record is promoting a Patriotic Bicycle Contest, and downtown stores will participate in a Patriotic Storefront Contest as well. City Administrator Toy Schulte will reach out to the county for any volunteer help. Mayor Carr would like to have someone provide sign language interpretation for the reading of the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United States. City Administrator Troy Schulte confirmed there will be a U.S. Army flyover featuring Chinook helicopters. Airport Manager Mike Wood stated that on July 5th he would need volunteers to ensure there is enough help on Sunday morning to pick up any leftover debris and trash since the airport will reopen at 9:00 a.m.

Tourism Director Rebecca Rupard shared that the small and medium-sized America 250 shirts were almost sold out and inquired whether another order should be placed so those sizes could be offered during the July 3 and July 4 events.
