America 250 Anniversary Events Update

Downtown Business Director Lagina Fitzpatrick stated that locations will be set up for the various activities, and Promotion and Events Coordinator Stashia Porter indicated she will provide a map and itinerary for those attending the America 250 Celebration events on July 3rd and 4th. Parking signs will be set up in several areas downtown for the community. Lagina Fitzpatrick shared that Ryan Sherrer reported that over 100 entries have been submitted for the art contest and requested that it be included, with attendees voting on the day of the event. Airport Manager Mike Wood indicated that all activities for July 4th at the airport are in place and Civil Air Patrol volunteers have been coordinated locally, and that the Fort Leonard Wood detachment will also be present to assist with traffic and parking needs.
