Call to Order, Roll Call, and Declaration of Quorum

Discussions and Presentations

America's 250 Anniversary Events Update

Mayor Carr noted that the Civic Center doors will open at 5:00 p.m. for the Diamond Rio concert, which is scheduled to begin at 7:00 p.m. He added that discussions are ongoing regarding live-streaming the event at various City facilities, as well as finalizing the ticketing process. Stashia Porter suggested establishing two concession locations and inquired whether the service would need to be bid out or if local civic clubs could be invited to participate as a fundraising opportunity. Chief Jerry Harrison, along with other security agencies, will be contacted regarding the services needed for the event. Results Advertising indicated that the store would operate with an open-door arrangement for two weeks, and purchasing bulk merchandise to sell at tables during the event may be the most efficient approach. Rebecca Rupard shared that Dawson and Hollow will provide entertainment on July 3, 2026. Stashia Porter shared that the banners will be ordered and placed on poles by January 2026.
